Miami, July 11, 2022 - Summer kicked off in the United States, with five times higher levels of Covid-19 cases compared to this same time last year, according to CDC data. Cases continue to rise in the country by the aggressively contagious Omicron sub-variants BA.4, BA.5, and local health authorities already foresee spikes after the July 4th celebration.

"Although many safety measures have been decreased with vaccination and the new studies on transmissibility, the cleanliness standards that were established with the pandemic will remain," says Dija Ziane, Head of Facility Services Division at Grupo EULEN, specialized in Aviation and Facility Services, including Sanitizing & Electrostatic Disinfecting (COVID-19) Services.
